SAFE CHURCH, SAFE COMMUNITIES TRAINING GUIDELINES

This document has been created to identify the modules that need to be completed for **Volunteers and Volunteer Leadership** to obtain the required certification. **Safe Church, Safe Community Training needs to be renewed every five years.**

The program/role areas listed are based on the category language used in Praesidium. To meet the requirements for Safe Church, Safe Community training you must take all the modules/classes listed under each category. For example, Work With Youth has five individual classes in the section. Once you have completed all classes the requirement for this area has been completed

What classes do I need to take?

The classes you need to take are based on your role in an area of ministry. Please use the corresponding ministry area or role to determine which classes need to be completed.

Children/Youth/Nursery

All non-paid persons who serve in staff positions and/or supervise, or assist with supervising children and youth, chaperone overnight events, or provide transportation.
